

H1N1 (SWINE FLU) CLINIC INFORMATION

H1N1 vaccine is being distributed in limited quantities to Indian River County physicians participating in Indian River County Health Department's (IRCHD) H1N1 vaccination campaign. If you are considered high risk for H1N1, please check with your physician to see if they have H1N1 vaccine for their high risk patients. If they do not have the vaccine, IRCHD has the following public vaccination clinics scheduled for high risk patients. All of our H1N1 vaccination clinics are free of charge, on a first come, first served basis and are voluntary.

Because we currently have limited amounts of vaccine, **if you are not in the high risk categories above, you will not be able to receive an H1N1 vaccination at any of these clinics.** We ask for your patience and understanding and encourage you to take precautionary measures to help protect yourself against this virus until the vaccination need for the high risk groups has been met and vaccine is made available to you in the near future.

What You Can Do To Protect Yourself from the H1N1 Virus

WASH HANDS often with soap and water, especially after coughing or sneezing. Use hand sanitizers if soap and water is not available.

COVER COUGHS & SNEEZES with a tissue or cough or sneeze into your elbow or shoulder – not into your hands.

KEEP SICK AT HOME for at least 24 hours after there is no longer a fever or signs of a fever (*without the use of fever-reducing medicine*).

GET VACCINATED for seasonal flu, which is available now, and H1N1 flu when it is available.

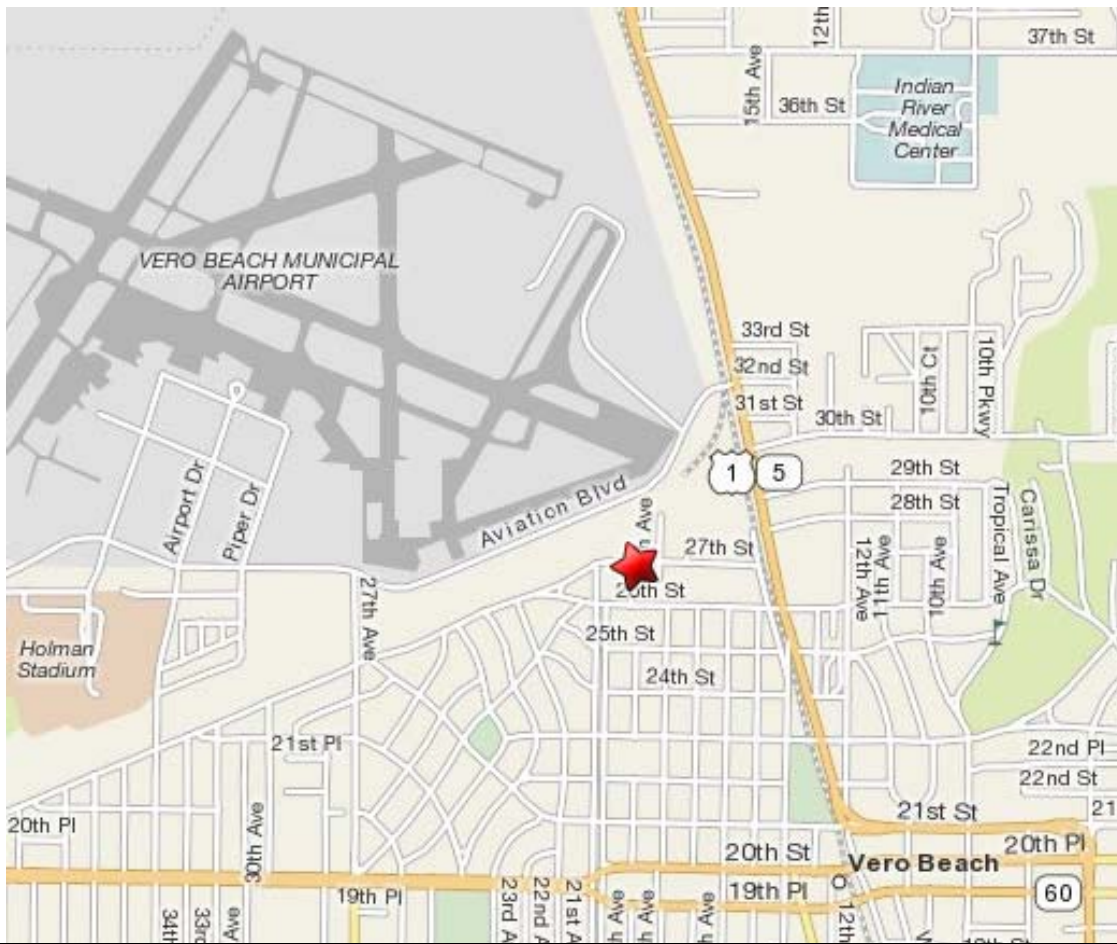
