- Safety
 - Parkland school shooting \rightarrow district asked for safety drills
 - Fire drills are done monthly last one completed on Tues.
 - Code Yellow drill completed this morning
 - ALL STUDENTS INSIDE and teachers teach after securing/locking the door and closing windows
 - Teachers handle their rooms
 - Code Red drill to be completed next week
 - LOCKDOWN imminent danger classroom must look empty. Kids away from view.
 - Meeting with teachers was on Tuesday re alarms
 - Upon Alarm activation: 1st check panel to determine source
 - If no reason identified, LOCKDOWN
 - B/F a drill Dr. Lord will notify teachers and staff

- Answers to questions:
 - We did tell the kids this time
 - No officer on site but we do have the presence of an officer around campus at times. District considering this issue as it is rare at elementary level.
 - We lock the gates and the classroom doors. Currently there are not repercussions if teachers forget to lock their door.
- Writing Support
 - All staff was involved in discussion about options
 - Recommendation to look at grade level expectations and try to build their own writing support.
 - Literacy team meeting: try to build upon staff recommendation.
 - Thinking Maps are still on the table
- District to release funds for 4/5 after school math tutoring
 - Due to low scores 20 students per grade
 - Teacher pay to tutor 10 students for 1 hr 2 X a week for 5 weeks
 - Budget \$2K
 - Dr. Lord proposed to release \$700 of SAC funds for materials for this program which will leave money for bus transportation for the students.
