Old Business:

We reviewed and unanimously approved minutes from December 11, 2015 SAC Meeting.

Principal's Report:

- Martin L. King, Jr. Parade – Mrs. Tetreault explained the new route and time we would meet to participate in the parade. We will stop at school and begin handing out water to support the parade participants as we are unsure of how many children may arrive without adults and want to be sure we have access to student information and be able to call parents. We sent home flyers for parents to sign/return but only a small number were returned.
- Instructional Rounds – we had district instructional rounds take place on Friday, Jan. 8th. Teams of teachers, admin and district level admin visited classrooms and observed instruction. We had very favorable feedback pertaining to instructional practice, gradual release of responsibility, school culture, student engagement. We will continue to work on implementing gradual release of responsibility (whole group instruction for a small portion of reading/math block and guiding students to independence.

- Florida State Assessment (FSA) District Training for Parents was provided. Parents were encouraged to attend as this presentation will help them understand how our school performed on the assessment and more information about the recently approved scales and school grades.
