Treasury Report:

Principial's Report:

Mrs. Tetreault presented the School Improvement Plan (SIP). Through collaborative planning and staff support, teachers will deepen understanding of Florida standards to plan and deliver lessons that implement the gradual release and responsibility model focused on students demonstrating mastery of skills. Differentiation will also be included within this standards-based instruction. Barriers have been addressed and strategies have been developed to correlate with barriers. Progress monitoring will be ongoing throughout all classes.

Our schools letter grade is a D. This grade is currently being contested due to enrollment/mobility rate. High mobility rates affect all educational areas – not just elementary schools. The DA works closely with us to ensure teacher and student success.

Staff developers from Columbia's Teacher College assists Dodgertown teachers 10 days per year. They thrive in providing our teachers with the tools to deliver balanced literacy and improve writing across all grade levels. The first Teacher's College professional developer was here on August 31st through September 2nd working with teachers from grades 3-5.

Presentations: Stacey Miller presented a power point about the meaning of SAC and why it is important to our school. She also presented the bylaws, allowed the room to read them, then asked for any questions. No questions were presented.

Continuous Improvement Model (CIM) Interventions are in place to make gains and increase proficiency and make significant overall gains in reading, math, and science.
