**Election of Executive Board:** No elections were made to the Student Advisory Council board.

**Treasury Report:**

As of 10/19/16, there is \$5,763.95 in the SAC budget.

**Request for Funds:** Ms. Sloan, a fourth grade teacher, came to the meeting requesting supplies for her grade level.

1. Time for Kids magazines are implemented as extra resources in the classrooms. These magazines are a great way to expose our students to more nonfiction materials while keeping them up to date on events in the world around them. The price for these magazines are: **\$307.74**

Mrs. Harrell made the motion to accept the request of funds for Time for Kids magazines in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms. Mrs. Cofressi seconded this motion. Vote was unanimous.

2. Recess Equipment: She has listed basketballs, hulla hoops, jump ropes, and a cart to carry the equipment to and from the classroom. The price is: **\$174.06**

Mrs. Shaler made the motion to accept the request for funds for recess equipment in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms. Mrs. Cofressi seconded. Vote was unanimous.

- We had a full house at Bring Your Parent to Breakfast on September 30<sup>th</sup>!
- Hurricane Matthew did not stop us from participating in National Walk to School Day on October 5<sup>th</sup>. We had over 100 students, teachers, and community members contribute to make this day successful.
- Lynn Mueller, author of Herbert the Hedgehog, presented to students in Library/Media on October 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Several of our teachers will be completing professional development with the Florida Diagnostic & Learning Resources System (FDLRS) on CHAMPS, a proactive and positive approach to classroom management. These strategies will be used in model classrooms around our school.
- The Differentiated Accountability Team (DA Team) will be completing walkthroughs on October 24<sup>th</sup> from 8:15-12.  
November 4<sup>th</sup>, dental screenings will be completed. From there, sealants will be included for those who qualify.
- iReady, a research-based, supplemental program that we implement, is used consistently across the district. It teaches to the students' strengths and struggles in the areas of Language Arts and Mathematics.
