Principial's Report:

We have some exciting things happening at Dodgertown!

- We had a full house at Bring Your Parent to Breakfast on September 30th!
- Hurricane Matthew did not stop us from participating in National Walk to School Day on October 5th. We had over 100 students, teachers, and community members contribute to make this day successful.
- Several of our teachers will be completing professional development with the Florida Diagnostic & Learning Resources System (FDLRS) on CHAMPS, a proactive and positive approach to classroom management. These strategies will be used in model classrooms around our school.
- iReady, a research-based, supplemental program that we implement, is used consistently across the district. It teaches to the students' strengths and struggles in the areas of Language Arts and Mathematics.
- Indian River County Schools has issued a mandated Cultural Competencies course for all employees. 100% of our Dodgertown staff has completed this course! ☺
- November 21st: Vero Beach High School band will perform for all students.

- November 21st: Thanksgiving Feast in the cafeteria during lunch periods. All families are invited to attend.
- November 30th: Math and Science Night from 5-6.
- December 15th: Winter Program including student performances from all grades K-5 from 6:00 P.M. to 7:30 P.M.

Presentations:

- Mr. Emilio Gonzalez presented school-wide discipline/referral and attendance data. *Attendance data is presented by grade level in the front office.* He also presented 3rd grade Baseline and Benchmark 1 data.
- Mrs. Denise Swanigan discussed the iReady program and how it is utilized in our school. Students will be completing the next data point (growth assessment) in January. There was an after-school math program provided to several students across the school.
- Ms. Jessica Cantlon discussed the future literacy after-school program that will begin for students in January. This program will focus on informational text and will last until 5 P.M. on meeting days. Both the literacy and math programs have utilized district benchmark data to better reach the needs of our students
