Principal's Report:

- Ms. Aretha Vernetta discussed grade level data from Performance Matters (3-5).
- 2016-2017, our school letter grade moved from a D to a C.
- 2017-2018, the goal is an A!

- Member of ULLC came to DTE to speak to faculty and learn about our school culture and climate.
- Ms. Vernetta discussed the options for school recognition funds distribution. After faculty voted, the winning choice was **option B**. It was brought before SAC to approve the results. *Mrs. Pearce made the motion to approve option B. Mrs. Carroll seconded. All votes to approve option B were unanimous.*

Option A: Split the school recognition funds equally between last year's 2016-2017 staff/employees/administration of Dodgertown Elementary School who were considered full time employees that were present for three-quarters of the 2016-2017 school year and pro-rate staff that were considered part-time (.5 or .8) that were present for three-quarters of the 2016-2017 school year.

Option B: Split the school recognition funds equally between the returning members of the 2016-2017 staff/employees of the 2016-2017 school year of Dodgertown Elementary School who were considered full and pro-rate staff that were considered part-time (.5 or .8).
