 - **Principal's Report:** Dodgertown Elementary is collecting money to donate to charities and local affiliations within our community. - **SBT Team** – This is a school based team that meets with each teacher in every grade level for an hour to discuss every student’s data, tardiness, early releases, academic data, assessment data, running records, math mini assessments, etc. The SBT team meets on a monthly rotation. The SBT team also discusses social-emotional behavior, academic issues, and discipline concerns that may affect the student’s ability to perform within their grade level.

- **i-Ready Winter Diagnostics #2: 3rd→December; K-2 & 4-5→January:** 3rd grade has taken the i-Ready diagnostic in December and in January Kindergarten, First, Second, Fourth, and Fifth grade will take the Winter Diagnostic.

- **Data→impact on Collaborative Planning:** Dodgertown Elementary is focused on data. The data has shown that Third grade and Fifth grade needs to have extra support and time provided to collaboratively plan. Collaborative planning has been directed to happen every morning at Dodgertown Elementary from 8:00-8:40am for all grade levels Kindergarten-Fifth grade. Additional training will be provided one time per month during the teacher’s cultural art planning time.
