Learning.com is already ready to go in every school. It varies school to school on if it is used and how it is used. There are also FSA tutorials. Teachers just hit assign. The classes are already in there and teachers just need to select their class. There are many options on how teachers assign the lessons. Data is accessible on how students are performing. The site has parent letters, and many resources available. This resource addresses one of our 3 barriers on the SIP. The other two are access to computers and time available. They can send us a link to the "12 essentials to Digital Literacy" in Learning. Com. This is a list of grade appropriate standards per grade level. The consensus is we need a laptop cart for the media center.
