Minutes Approval: A motion was made by Brian Holmes to approve the February minutes and seconded by Mike Greto.

Technology:

New laptop cart is on campus. S. Simpson is inclined to use it in the Library. Ellen Probst has retired and Ms. Rodriguez will take over the position in the fall. This position will be a media and technology center. She will provide support with technology education, as well as research. There is a school time survey on the District Web Site. S. Simpson is encouraging us to go on and take the survey for the 2018 school year.

School Culture Committee: Due to a drop of in volunteers a committee was formed between SAC and the PTA to generate ideas to make our campus more welcome, while keeping it safe. A few ideas that were generated include a Principal's Coffee that would take place once in the beginning of the year and later in the year. After the breakfast ambassadors would tour parents around the school and introduce them to volunteer opportunities on the campus. Another idea were courtyard conservations and Boo Hoo breakfasts for Kindergarten parents to get acquainted with one another and be introduced to opportunities to help on campus. For single point of entry, that will take next place next school year, different suggestions were made involving the front gate being open during drop off, etc. K. Rahal gave a presentation on dismissal procedures. We have about 72 bus students, 93 After Care, 142 Car Rider and 166 Walk-up students. Bus has mostly behavior issues, and car-pick up / walk up has some safety concerns. Suggestions have been made to putting walk-up in the first row on the West side of the cafeteria. Another suggestions would be to switch kindergarten and walk-up seating areas. Concerns are where parents might park to pick up their child.

It is a good reminder that all the different things going on in our school, we are doing a lot of things right and we are a great school. Thanks was given to our SAC members.
