Discipline Data-presented by Mrs. Hofer, handouts reflected the number of Friday detentions, ISS and OSS. Numbers for ISS and OSS have decreased greatly from 2014/2015 SY. Data to be shared with state officials this week as a result of OMS being flagged last SY for disproportionate levels of ISS and OSS for ESE and African American Students. Data shared reflects individual subgroups. Decrease in OSS and ISS could be due to several variables including increased student engagement, decreased referrals written by teachers due to the increase in classroom interventions attempted and successful, increased use of after sch. Detentions and/or change in campus climate.

SAC-Substance Abuse Council, Christina DeFalco director of Life Skills Program and M. Z. Introduced the Life Skills Program teaching communication skills, coping mechanisms, and social skills; highlighted the HEY, PARENT pledge addressing alcohol/drug and tobacco usage—encourages parents to say NO to serving underage teens alcohol. Handouts provided encouraging parents to take the nooneshouse.com hoping to keep alcohol out of the hands of teens.
