Principals Update:

- Updated on A/C issue reporting more stability and continued communication to complete the A/C project soon
- Dads Breakfast on Wednesday 9/28 2016 – Inviting dads to come have breakfast with the students to improve school culture. Pledge from State will be read and Video from previous years will be shown.
- Oct 5th is National Walk to School Day and Oslo will participate by meeting at the new Intergenerational building at 8:00am to walk to school together as a group. Security has been coordinated with local law enforcement
