Principals Update:

- School was used as a shelter during Hurricane Irma and it faired very well. The school had very minimal damage.
- Oslo is in the process of hiring 5 new interventionist teachers for ELA/MATH/SCIENCE through the UNISIG grant that only underperforming schools are eligible to receive.
- All AC work has been completed and we are hoping that it will provide more temperature consistency
- I-Ready diagnostic tests are complete and teachers should be providing student data at parent teacher conferences on 9/27 & 9/28.

Title 1:

- Parent Compact was presented and reviewed. SAC chair opened the floor for discussion and input on the Parent Compact. Parents gave comments about the benefit of the handout and how it creates accountability. No changes were added to the compact. The floor was closed and SAC chair opened for voting. A motion was made first by C.Tate and 2nd by A. Stephens. All present were in favor.
- School Improvement Plan was discussed and reviewed the two goals.

- Goal 1: Increase school culture and climate through a school wide Tier 1 Behavior Plan. Our Believe in Blue campaign incorporates attendance, suspension, academic progress, and success skills. This plan will decrease the number of referrals from 2016-2017 by 20%.
- Goal 2: A focus on standards based instruction which includes quality formative assessments and rigor will increase student achievement.
- The Floor was opened and parents asked clarifying questions about the two goals below. Parents wanted to know more about standards based grading and the specifics of the support team involved in the Believe in Blue campaign. Parents did not wish to add or delete any part of the goals. The discussion was closed, and SAC chair opened the floor for voting. A motion was made 1st by S. D'Alessio and 2nd by S. McGary. All present voted in favor.

Funding Request:

Mr. Shannon Wiley requested up to 1500.00 for art enhancement materials that will be used to help the students engage in hands on learning experiences. The SAC team discussed and a motion was made 1st by S. D'Alessio and a 2nd by B. Holmes. Mr. Wiley will be providing a purchase order and will return any unused funds.
