Budget Update: Funds at \$8,880

Principals Update:

- Today (2/26) we had a DA visits from the state and district personnel. We had a Community Action Team (CAT). The visit went very well and they were impressed with the growth. All classrooms that were visited had small group and personalized instruction.
- Looking at I-Ready predicted growth over half have already achieved a half year growth. We have 55% Math and 56% in ELA. Our goal is to have half make a year learning gain.
- A couple of months ago the soccer and softball fields were vandalized by a car doing circles. The vandal has been caught and is paying reparations. Softball field bases and fences will be put in.
- Roariffic Reading on March 1st will turn into Mathapooloza. Parents and students will be exposed to sample items and games. Mr. Teske will also be coming on March 1st for parents to ask questions about safety and operations.
- Community Credit Union donated a TOY and EOY banner.
- Yearbooks are on sale for 30\$
- We are providing ongoing professional development for staff. Kagan Training will be offered in April to 10 teachers. Also, we have Tier 3 intervention- Leveled Literacy Reading to help provide personalized learning to all students.
- Dr. Rendell created a safety letter and is posted on the district website, but it is also sent home with the students.
- On Wednesday 2/28, we will be having a safety meeting and going over our active shooter/intruder drill
- We are applying for the 5 STAR Award and we need parent volunteers' hours for us to be eligible. Please come out and volunteer.
