What is Title 1?

- Large federally funded program
- Public schools qualify when there is a high % of economically disadvantaged students which is based on the # on free and reduced lunch.
- All students in title 1 schools are eligible for title 1 services.
- 12 school is IRC are title 1 this 2018-2019 school year
- **Funds:** Title 1 funds supplement programs, pay for coaches/teacher assistants, material/resources needed to support the SIP or PIP
- Parent involvement plan will be provided at open house
- **Accountability:** School held accountable and awarded grades - A, B, C, D, Sebastian earned a "B". Went over the other title 1 school grades.
- **SPAR:** Can be found on the district website- A report on progress of the schools
- **FL Standards:** gets students ready for college and career. Family nights will help parents support these standards at home.
- **Curriculum:** Discuss curriculum being used with classroom teacher, curriculum has been selected to meet proficiency, visit the schools website/district page
- **Parent Engagement:** Have regular, meaningful communication, PIP, Parents Right to know about professional qualifications, FSA (Be sure to get these at open house if you haven't received your child's score), family nights, conferences
