A. Meeting was called to order by Mr. Valencia at 3:34 p.m.

C. There were several new members in attendance: freshman student Stephanie Giordano, Mori Serpa with Seacoast Bank.

D. The minutes of the September 28, 2015 were reviewed. Mr. Racine motioned to approve. Mrs. Holmes seconded. Minutes were approved unanimously.

E. Budget requests:

- Mr. Brown's funding request to provide peer mediation/conflict resolution was approved during the September meeting, and he will submit the appropriate fund request form for processing. Mr. Valencia will follow up with Mr. Brown.
- Ms. Holmes did a follow up report on a previous request in August 2015 for a wireless multi-function laser presenter device. She re-surveyed the teachers to find out who needed one, and a total of 32 teachers responded in the affirmative. The cost is approximately \$14.39 per device. A total of \$460.48 was approved. Mrs. Nicolace motioned to approve. Mr. Kayser seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

F. Sharing-

- Mr. Racine shared that there were unspent funds on the state mandated teacher classroom funds (on debit cards) distributed last year totaling \$2204.19, so that amount has been transferred into the SAC funds. Our budget is now \$18,300.79.
- Mr. Kayser, PTSA President, reported on last Saturday's Homecoming Dance. Mr. Racine shared the spirit week festivities.
- Mr. Racine reported that over the weekend SRHS hosted the Shark Invitational Cross Country meets. We have several runners who are moving on to the next competition.
- SRHS is 2nd place in the district for football, so will be in the playoffs.
- Band won the Crown Jewel for the sixth straight year.
- In the middle of FSA reading re-takes. Next round will begin the end of November.
- Mrs. Holmes shared that In The Bag is up to 80 for Fellsmere and 25 for Indian River Academy, in addition to providing food to eight families from SRHS. Seacoast/Mrs. Serpa is adopting some families for Thanksgiving and Christmas. She also coordinates an adopt a family quarter auction program through the American Legion. Mr. Kayser offered to donate the leftover candy and cookies from the dance. Mr. Finke from Winn Dixie also offered to assist.
- Mr. Racine announced that the school is collecting books for the Moonshot Moment (pre-school, elementary).

K. Adjournment-- Mrs. Scaramuzzi motioned to adjourn. Mr. Giordano seconded. Meeting adjourned at 4:10 p.m.
