C. Sharing

Ms. Holmes presented SIP goals, strategies, and implementation procedures to further improve our school climate. Discipline data was shared with the committee. Items such as referrals by grade and ethnicity, suspensions both OSS and ISS were reviewed. We were made aware of conflict resolution teams, after school tutoring programs, peer tutoring and focus on graduation requirements in a timely fashion to insure success. The overall consensus is that we are moving in the right direction and we have seen improvement. Referrals and suspensions are down compared to the same time and students from last year. Our discipline numbers continue to exceed expectations.
