School Advisory Committee

The SRMS School Advisory Committee (SAC) meeting took place on Monday, May 9, 2016.

The meeting was called to order by Meredith Tatro at 3:45 p.m. In attendance were: Meredith Tatro-SAC Chair, Jody Idlette-Principal, Amanda King, Richelle Cluck, Shameka McCombs-Owens, Joanna Roux, Caroline Maschhoff, Mia Johnson, Lis Bech, Sharon, Dotson, Kim Auger, and Pattie Schultz.

The committee reviewed the minutes from the March 14th meeting. Lis Bech moved to approve the minutes and Shamika McCombs-Owens seconded the motion. All members approved.

Mrs. Tatro had a funding request to cover the teacher salaries for running Cowboy Camp for incoming 6th graders. It will cost approximately \$1,200. As of last year, the number of teachers was reduced from 5 to 4 for the 2 day program. The Camp will include an introduction to the school, showing incoming students how to open their lockers, read their schedules, and tour the school. We will have 2 morning sessions and 2 afternoon sessions. Final dates to be determined. Denise Griffin motioned to approve the fund request and Sharon Dotson seconded the motion.

Mrs. Auger shared the Math School Improvement Plan and explained how the students use the Performance Scale to rate their level of learning as compared to the learning goals on the template. Mrs. Schultz had two students from 7th grade and two students from 8th grade present what they were doing in the Science department.
