**MEETING SUMMARY: DISCUSSION / TOPICS**

- 1) Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Angie Herman at 3:34 p.m.
- 2) Approval of January 2018 SAC Meeting Minutes: Marie Gruber made a motion to approve and Delayne Krenek seconded to approve the January minutes.
- 3) Visitor / Newcomer Introductions. No visitors.
- 4) Principal's updates:
  - a. Lacrosse, Softball and Baseball sports have begun. All games on calendar.
  - b. Casual For a Cause February – American Heart Association. \$541.30
  - c. Girls Lacrosse fundraiser was held on February 12, 2018.
  - d. Chick Fil A night on February 22, 2018 to support PBS.
  - e. Band – 11 students earned superior and 2 earned excellent ratings at FL Bandmasters Association Solo & Ensemble Music Performance.
  - f. Academic Games – a number of students are headed to States for Academic Games
  - g. iReady Data – We are now coming into testing season, and using iReady to prepare for FSA. Students recently practiced writing prompts. Students in lowest quartile for Language Arts and Math were identified and teachers were given notice to keep them on radar and work towards encouraging and helping them to succeed. Chris Taylor from District testing met with teachers to analyze data and suggest approaches for working with the data and encouraging learning gains. iReady designed for all level students, not just lower end.
  - h. SGMS received a Math Grant from the Education Foundation in the amount of \$2000, where math teachers will host a Saturday, Wednesday, Saturday Math Camp prior to FSA. These workshops will be for students and parents.

- 5) PTSA Update – working on Box Tops fundraiser. Deadline is Friday, February 23, 2018. A Connect Ed reminder call will go out tomorrow night. The Mixed Bag fundraiser is also in progress.
- 6) Old Business: Request for SAC Funds. Mrs. Bieber drafted a SAC Grant Request form for approval so teachers can formally request funds, and either be approved or denied. A suggestion was made to add “please have the application submitted electronically one week prior to the SAC meeting at which the request will be considered.” Marie Gruber made a motion to approve the Grant Request Application as amended.
- 7) New Business: Mrs. Eberhart requested SAC funds in the amount of \$750 per grade level to be used for student driven incentives for learning gains. Faculty has priced out a few incentive options and came up with the price of \$750 per grade level. Motion passed unanimously.
- 8) Marie Gruber asked Ms. Bieber to address school safety. Principal’s meeting will be later this week to address safety and active shooter training. Ms. Bieber reminded everyone to spread the mantra, “If you see something, say something.” Strategic plans are in place to keep the staff and students safe. Parents should ensure that the District has their current contact phone number on file for Connect Ed updates.
