Treasure Coast Elementary School SAC Meeting March 23, 2015

In attendance: Kelly Baysura, Jennifer Freeland, Wendee Haddick, Tiffany Lyford

Kelly Baysura called the meeting to order at 3:50 p.m.

The previous meeting's minutes were reviewed as follows:

The River Rocks are in the process of being painted now.

The newest Professional Development just started.

Wendee Haddick motioned to approve the minutes. Jennifer Freeland seconded the motion. Minutes approved.

Kelly Baysura gave an update on the upcoming construction project.

She has met with Scott Sanders from Facilities Management. The parking lot construction project is scheduled to begin in June. It is currently out to bid. The proposal to complete both parking lots (front and back) was voted on and approved. The front parking lots will extend over to the field. There will be bumpers placed around the speed bumps in the parent pickup line to prevent cars from driving around the bumps and destroying the grass. There will be a one way bypass from the parent pickup lane into the parking area to help prevent congestion or someone being stuck in the pickup line by mistake. There may be a loss of a few parking spaces from the original proposal due to lighting. A running path will also be installed as well as the sidewalk drainage issue will be fixed.

The entire perimeter of the school will be fenced. There will be a gate in the back for emergency access. Security cameras are going to be installed on the interior and exterior of the school. Kelly will be able to access the cameras remotely. The project is currently out for state bid. More information will be given at a later date.

There was also discussion of relocating the front door of the school to the immediate left side of where it currently is. This would force visitors to walk directly into the front desk. The idea of a wall being placed there so that visitors would have to be buzzed into the school (after seeing the front desk) was also addressed. Kelly will talk to Scott about it. Wendee Haddick asked about more picnic tables being placed outside of the cafeteria to allow for more seating when parents eat lunch with their children. Kelly said that was something she would like to see happen and would look into it.

Meeting adjourned at 4:50. The next meeting will be May 18th, 2015.
