### Opening

### Principal's Report

- 1) The treasury has a balance of \$2,289.71. The budget decreased to fund mentors and substitutes so that our staff can attend Professional Development to make us the best school that we can be.
- 2) Committee agreed to fund the Gator Express, books, school busses, and ice cream for the event.

### New Business

- 1) **Gator Express:** Our Fall Gator Express will take place on 11/03/18 from 10:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Mr. Faust opened up discussion on whether or not to do a turkey giveaway. Committee approved funding ice cream and busses up to \$500.00.
- 2) **SIP Update/Planning-** Committee funded \$5,000 for teacher training. If we can improve core instruction in Science, Reading, and Mathematics our school grade will also improve. We have added Gator Time for grades 2-5. Mr. Faust posed the question, how do we support African America students, and foster a sense of community and build positive relationships with these students? We are going to focus on recruiting mentors for our students.
- 3) **Parent Recruitment Ideas-** Gator Express is scheduled for November 3<sup>rd</sup>. We are planning on raffling off tickets for a turkey giveaway. SAC to look for local sponsors to donate turkeys or Thanksgiving meals. We are also planning a Parent's Night in October or November. October 26 is the tentative date for the Glow Dance.
- 4) **Impact Information:** Staff will be conducting Data Chats, where we will be diving into the data, and seeing what skills our students need to master in order to be proficient.
