- Meeting was called to order at 3:46pm

New Business

- Overview of SAC-
  - Mrs. Matheny discussed the purpose of SAC with parents and teachers. Grateful for high turnout of parents today.
- SIP-
  - Mrs. Matheny discussed last year's SIP goals of 50% proficiency for Reading, 50% proficiency for Math and 50% proficiency for Science and how we met or exceeded those goals for Math and Science. New SIP goals were shared, as follows, 50% for Reading, 65% for Math, and 55% for Science.
  - A parent asked how school score is calculated. Mrs. Matheny drew a quick diagram and described the data that is used to calculate school score. Parents asked for this diagram to be created and shared with all the parents in school to share how important parents are in their child's learning. One parent stated, "One student makes a difference!" and that they would like to get more parents involved in their children's academics.
  - Mrs. Matheny discussed parent engagement portion of the SIP. 80 parents attended Title One night, highest number in the district. 30 parents came to Day of Caring. FES was awarded Golden School House from FL DOE based on high number of volunteer hours. Curriculum nights will be held to engage parents and students in home to school/school to home connection. Parents would like awards ceremonies to be held in the evening versus during the school day, only students receiving awards would be given invitations, pizza dinner as incentive.

- Review of all dates-
