Meeting called to order at 3:45pm

Old Business

- Reading and Approval of the September SAC Minutes- Minutes were read and approved.

New Business

- Family Survey- Mrs. Matheny/Mr. Echeverria- Tabled for next meeting due to time constraints.
- Approve School Grade Flyer- Mrs. Matheny shared the school grade information flyer she developed based on feedback from parents at the September SAC meeting. Parents approved the flyer with minor change addressing highlighting our school score and showing one point difference between 'C' and 'B' score. Mrs. Matheny stated the flyer would be translated and sent out to families soon.
- School Safety- Deputy Ian McKay reviewed school safety protocols and shared Mr. Teske from the district believes FES is 'ahead of the game and being practical'. FES will have an active shooter drill on November 16th and a staff meeting on November 2nd to review teacher/staff expectations during the drill. Prior to these dates, Deputy McKay will meet with every individual teacher in his or her classroom to review and discuss details on an individual, per classroom basis. Deputy McKay shared that our code red, blue, and yellow drills and fire drills thus far have been successful. He shared the following areas of concern that are still be addressed:
 - Cell phone reception: Poor at best. All the parents on SAC were not happy about this as it affects student safety.
 - Wifi reception: Poor at best.
 - Handheld radios: Multiple dead spots/areas on campus. All the parents on SAC were again, not happy about this as it affects student safety. A company can come out and believes it can fix this issue by turning up the 'power' setting and re-adjusting the signals to be set at the same signal point. This will cost around \$1,000 for 50 radios. Deputy McKay asked for SAC approval to use SAC funds to cover expenses. Mr. Noe Chico approved, seconded by Mr. Hiram Serrano.
