<u>Approval of Minutes</u>- A motion was made by to approve the minutes by Nate Bruckner and seconded by Curtis Carpenter.

<u>Use of SAC funds-</u> Requesting \$1500.00 for travel to Jacksonville for 3 days for subs, meals, mileage, and hotel for Pre-K - K Singapore Math training for two new teachers-Ms. Kipp and Ms. Meyers. In all, we will need \$9000 for training this year. Two other funding sources are \$1,000 from the Ed. Foundation, and \$6,000 from the California Grant. Currently, we have \$13,396 in SAC funds. In addition, we believe we will receive additional SAC funds. However, we don't know what we will receive. We need to reserve \$3,325 for vertical planning from last year, in case we are billed for that cost. Nate Bruckner requested an annual Singapore Math budget to help us move forward. Next month, Scott Simpson will give us a more itemized budget for Singapore for the rest of the school year. Curtis Carpenter made a motion to approve the funds and it was seconded by Nate Bruckner. The vote was approved unanimously.
