- Update on School Improvement Plan- Mr. Echeverria/Mrs. Matheny-
 - Update on SIP, no changes from original plan. Same mission, moving forward towards our reading goals: ELA- 50%, Math- 65%, Science 55%. Mrs. Matheny also shared with parents how to access our SIP via the school district website.
- Parent Survey Review- Mr. Echeverria/Mrs. Matheny-
 - Schools are trying to work with parents to make school better. Parents read and reviewed the 2018 Parent Survey. The parents do not find completing the survey to be a burden. Parents can access the form online. The front office staff enters all information into the computer.

- Mr. Chico provided feedback from FES Friday Night Awards ceremony: 1. per family but add an additional spot for number of people attending with each family. 4.
