- March 8<sup>th</sup> Active Shooter Drill Update- Deputy McKay:
  - FES will have an active shooter drill, day will be provided but not the time. It will be scenario based. The district has requested monthly active shooter drills. Teachers were sent a survey to ask about amount of instructional time to prepare for the drills and how they are affecting students academically and emotionally. FES is getting a single point entry. Construction will begin after Spring Break. April's active shooter drill will be practiced in the cafeteria.
  - Safety Questions: Mr. Chico asked about lights for evening events on campus. Mrs. Matheny addressed this, as a priority but it will not occur until after the single point entry construction is completed. Looking into temporary lighting outside of cafeteria during the construction phase.
- Ice Cream Celebration: Mrs. Matheny/Mr. Echeverria
  - All students given ice cream to celebrate their hard work and efforts on the winter iReady diagnostic assessment.
- Soccer Goals: Coach Miller and Coach Hulings
  - Coach Miller and Coach Hulings discussed the need for new goal posts. All 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> graders use these during recess and for certain PE activities. The set would cost around \$5,000 and have a 5 year warranty, as well as anchors for hurricanes. Asking SAC to fund the purchase. Approved by Mr. Chico and seconded by Mrs. Zamarripa.

Open Forum-

5th grade Body Projects: Mr. Chico shared how impressed he was with the students researching and creating models of various body/organ parts. Mrs. Matheny lead everyone through the 5<sup>th</sup> grade hallway to show the parents the projects.
