II Principal's Report:

- i-Ready Diagnostics #3 underway (May 2019)
- DTE Parent Survey (20% Needed): 118 out of 430 = 27% (Last Year 107 out of 406 = 26%)
- Spring i-Ready Diagnostic Reading data: Implications (Phonics and Vocabulary→Writing)

Ms. Vernette spoke about the Principal report and shared information about our School Based Team (SBT) meetings and data the team discusses about each child in every grade level, focusing on the whole child: academic, social-emotional, and behavior.

Ms. Vernette spoke about the importance of parent surveys and parent feedback. Ms. Vernette shared the parent survey data which was 1% higher than last year. Parent surveys collected this year totaled 118 out of 430= 27% total (Last year 107 out of 406= 26%).

Ms. Vernette spoke about 3rd grade i-Ready testing. Ms. Vernette shared information about concerns for incoming third grade students surrounding the need for vocabulary and phonics skills. To address this, issue the work supporting a systematic delivery of phonics instruction and support is needed.

A request was made for Sadlier Phonics Level A: 36 books at the amount of \$13.49 per book plus, \$50.00 for shipping for a total of \$535.64. After discussion of reusing the books or consuming the books requested to be used for Grade 1. Mr. Gaulkins offered to match the request personally to support the efforts to meet the needs of the students surrounding phonics instruction. Mr. Gaulkins, motioned to approve the request for funds. The motion was seconded by Barbara Pearce. Stacey Miller made the motion to approve. Vote to accept was unanimous. No opposed.

Stacey Miller spoke about the potential for the SAC member to serve on the SAC committee for the upcoming school year. The fourth Tuesday of the month will be the date of our SAC meetings. A date was set for August 27, 2019 at 8:00am and the location will be determined.
