Stacey Miller called the meeting to order at 8:00 A.M.

Introductions of the faculty, parents, and community members were made. Stacey Miller is the chair of the Dodgertown SAC committee. She asked for any parents or community members who are willing to be on the SAC committee to raise a hand and be voted on by parent/community SAC members.

- **Approval of Minutes from March 26, 2019 meeting.**

Sue Carroll, motioned to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Lawrence Gaulkin. Stacey Miller made the motion to approve. Vote to accept was unanimous. No opposed.

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**I New Business:** Mrs. Stacey Miller spoke about the events happening at the school and invited the SAC members to be a part of any upcoming events that interested them. **Mrs. Miller spoke about our schoolwide events and shared information about each event on our school calendar.**

## II Principal's Report:

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Ms. Vernet spoke about the Principal report and shared information about FSA testing dates. April 2 2019 was the FSA Writing Assessment for (4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>) and April 2-3, 2019 was FSA ELA Assessment (3<sup>rd</sup>). May 1 FSA ELA Session 1 (Grades 4 and 5) and May 2 FSA ELA Session 2 (Grades 4-5). May 06 FSA Math Session 1 (Grades 3,4,5) and May 07: FSA Math Session 2 (Grades 3, 4, and 5), May 08: SSA Science Session 1 (Grade 5) May 09: SSA Science Session 2 (Grade 5).

Ms Vernet shared information about i-Ready Spring Diagnostic Testing Dates: April 22: Grade 3 ELA Spring Assessment, and May 1-20: i-Ready Window for remaining Spring assessments. Ms. Vernet spoke about 3<sup>rd</sup> grade i-Ready testing. Ms. Vernet spoke about students must score a reading achievement level higher than a 1 on the FSA. If not, then the student needs a score of 535 on the Spring diagnostic reading assessment to be promoted to fourth grade. Letters have gone out to students in grade 3 about summer school and are due back to DTE on May 1.

Ms. Vernet spoke about the importance of parent surveys and parent feedback. Ms. Vernet spoke about the Panaroma survey that students in grade 3-5 are requested to complete. Panaroma is important feedback of our students social, emotional, and mental needs.

A request was made for headphones, rolling carts, large tubs (16), and Jan Richardson's books on guided reading. The total request was \$1,787.50 for these items. Craig Walker, motioned to approve the request for funds. The motion was seconded by Sue Carroll. Stacey Miller made the motion to approve. Vote to accept was unanimous. No opposed.
