Present: Meredith Tatro, Mr. Todd Racine (Principal), Jacquelyn Ogilvie, Marie Taglione, Briceli Gamez, Ron Rompot, Julie Pelletier, James Thimmer, and Patty Giordano

Call to order – 3:47pm

Introductions: Everyone introduced themselves. Election of SAC chair, Meredith Tatro, was motioned by Jackie Ogilvie and seconded by Ron Rompot. All in favor. No opposed. Election of secretary will be done at next meeting. Mr. Ken Brown was nominated.

Review of Minutes from May meeting. No changes necessary. Motion to approve by Jackie Ogilvie, Seconded by Ron Rompot. All in favor. No opposed.

Funding Requests: Mrs. Tatro shared a list of everything SAC funded for the 2018-2019 school year. Also, the SAC account balance is over \$15,000. right now.

Patty Giordano/SWAG – SWAG (Students With Attendance Goals) is a student group advised by Mrs. Giordano. Improving student attendance is one of SRMS's goals and many tracking/incentives are used to motivate students to be in school. The funding request was for \$800 (\$400 each semester) for awards and incentives. Motion to approve was made by Meredith Tatro, seconded by Marie Taglione. All in favor. No opposed.

Mr. Racine – Two requests were made. The first request was to fund the afterschool busses for students to be involved in clubs or attend tutoring. The amount requested it \$1750. Motion to approve was made by Meredith Tatro, seconded by Marie Taglione. All in favor. No opposed. The second was to fund cafeteria monitors, 2 per lunch at \$367.51 each, for a total of \$2205.06, and a detention monitor for \$735.02. Motion to approve was made by Briceli Gamez, seconded by Ron Rompot. All in favor. No opposed.

Principal's Report/Good News –Mr. Racine shared that SRMS is working to become a five-star school and one of the requirements is for SAC to meet 8 times during the school year.

Mr. Thimmer shared information on the single-point entry that will be starting construction in a few months and will take 6-8 months to complete. The goal is to have it completed by the start of the 2019-2020 school year. Plans for entry during the construction are being worked on by Mr. Thimmer and Mr. Racing and a meeting regarding this plan with district officials is being planned. Adjustments to the drop-off/pick-up loop will need to be made but will not be finalized until after the meeting.
