May 14, 2019

A motion was made by Craig McCoy to add an item to the agenda, "Request for Funds". Brian Holmes seconded the motion.

Minutes Approval: A motion was made by Curtis Carpenter to approve the minutes and seconded by Craig McCoy.

Fundraising: There will be a copy going home tomorrow in Wednesday folders regarding the Osceola Magnet School Investment Opportunity. Nate Bruckner and others put this banner plan together.

Request for Funds: Terri Rollins and the literacy committee was tasked to look at our Response to Intervention (RTI). We wanted to be sure that we have the tools needed to help our lowest quartile students. We found that Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI), is being used by every other school in the district. She would like us to help us buy the "Gold System" to work with the "Blue System", we already have, to make this program work most effectively. It is a one-time purchase. There are also on-line resources. It is researched based and includes a running record to track each student's progress. Terri Rollins has used it before and she is able to train teachers. The total request is \$5984.00. Curtis Carpenter made a motion to approve the funds and Brian Holmes seconded the motion. It was approved unanimously.

Principal's Report: We are getting two new teachers next year- a 3rd grade Reading Interventionist and a second ESE teacher. Many teachers, parents and administrators visited another school today in Palm Bay to look at the FUSE program and discuss how it could be implemented in our school. It is out of Northwestern University. The focus would be for 4th and 5th grade students. The initial cost is \$17,000 and it costs about \$5,000 a year. This is something we will consider implementing in the future. We are the South County Summer School site. Liberty Magnet is the North County school. Dr. Rendell has resigned, and the interim superintendent and a long-term deputy superintendent will be voted in tonight. Melissa Brown has been PTA President for over 2 years and we are thankful for all she has done for our school.

PTA Report: New Board members have been voted in. The PTA has given \$16,000 to teachers and the school from their fundraising. This is the last week the PTA store will be opened.
