MEETING SUMMARY: DISCUSSION / TOPICS

- 1) Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Tracey Barker at 3:29 pm.
- 2) Visitors: Stacey Klim, Marquerite Ogilvie, Keandra Foster, SGMS Assistant Principal Eddie Robinson, SGMS Assistant Principal, & Danyelle Sessoms, SGMS Media Specialist
- 3) Principal's updates:
 - a) 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan was broken down and explained by Ms. Bieber and Ms. Foster. They shared the web address; www.floridacims.org where the entire plan for SGMS can be found. Some of the contents that were mentioned:

Ms. Bieber provided a printout which reflected the breakdown of the school grade with the comparison of the other 3 middles schools- OMS, SRMS, & GMS.

❖ Re-Decorating/Arranging Classrooms

Ms. Bieber made mention that in the first faculty meeting that suggested to teachers to think of re-arranging/decorating classrooms to improve student motivation, engagement, & interest.

4) New Business:

- a) Request for SAC funds from Ms. Sessoms, SGMS Media Specialist to renew the Accelerated Reader program. The renewal cost for the 2019-2020 school year is \$6550.00 which included a \$500.00 discount from its original cost of \$7000.00. The quote reflects 900 student subscriptions. Ms. Sessoms brought forward the request to boost student incentive which brings the hopes to increase reading testing scores. A motion was made by Marie Gruber and seconded by T Pring Asencio. All were in favor and the funds are approved.
- b) Request for SAC funds from Keandra Foster, SGMS Assistant Principal for Tuesday after school busing through SDIRC Transportation Dept. The 2018-2019 costs were 1788.70 for student busing for after school programs such as; clubs, sports, tutoring classes, etc. The funds were being requested for the take home transportation for students interested in the same programs within the 2019-2020 school year. A motion was made by Marie Gruber and seconded by T Pring Asencio. All were in favor and the funds are approved.
- c) b) Request for SAC funds from Keandra Foster, SGMS Assistant Principal for teacher pay for tutoring students' after school on Tuesdays. Ms. Foster mentioned that the after school tutoring would only benefit student achievement. A motion was made by Marie Gruber and seconded by Delayne Krenek. All were in favor and the funds are approved.
- d) Ms. Bieber made mention and thanked the SAC committee for always being diligent towards the needs and the success of the students, faculty, & staff of SGMS.
