Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Nate Bruckner to approve August's minutes and seconded by Craig McCoy.

**Budget:** Our SAC budget as of now is \$4,603.29. We don't know what to anticipate from the state. History has shown inconsistencies in our receipt of money coming in from the state. In our fundraising account, we anticipate about \$800 in income from sponsorships. In our WSJF Account, we have received a \$6,000 grant. We can anticipate this to go up to about \$10,000 next year. Roughly, it looks that our total expenses are about \$8,000 a year.

**Fundraising**: We have our first completed banner that will go up today. Another will hopefully follow later this week. We may change banner companies due to an unanticipated increase in price.

**School Improvement Plan:** SIP Plan goals were presented and reviewed. The first is Small Group Instruction: Daily, Targeted, Monitored, Research Based Framework. The second is Social Emotional Learning- Establishing an Environment of Caring and Resiliency. Discussion was given to how we measure the Social Emotional Learning goal. Nate Bruckner made a motion to approve the plan and it was seconded by Craig McCoy. It was approved unanimously.

**PTA Report:** Fall Fundraiser packets go home tomorrow. As of now, 344 members have paid dues and our goal is 350. They are due 9/24 and they will be fulfilled the first week of November. They are looking for speakers for assemblies. Also, Mrs. Bruckner has stepped down as the parent representative and Mrs. Young has taken her place.

**Principal's Report:** The Open House has been moved until 9/19<sup>th</sup>. We feel very fortunate to have had Hurricane Dorian pass us by.

**Other Business:** Discussion was given in regard to car pick-up and concern about the time it takes to pick up your child and how cars obstruct the neighbor's driveways. It was recommended that we move to two lanes.
