Opening

The regular meeting of the Glendale Elementary - School Advisory Committee was called to order at 4:00 PM on 9/10/19 in room 514 by Principal Adam Faust.

Present

Approval of Minutes

Meeting minutes from August 20th were amended on 9/10/19 to change the word "leave money" to "lead money".

Chairman's Report

Ms. Poysell stated that we made it through Hurricane Dorian and that we are starting September with strong momentum.

Principal's Report

- 1) The treasury has a balance of \$4,211.32
- 2) SIP Update: This is a working document. To access the SIP go to the district website our schools elementary Glendale students/ families Title I then you will see the PFEP/Compact. We review this document regularly to make sure our school is on the right track. We reviewed is as a team and unanimously approved the document as is online.
- 3) Open House and PTA Meeting is this Thursday.

New Business

- 1) We need to determine how to use the treasury balance of \$4,211.32.
 - a) The SAC Committee unanimously voted to add \$2,000 to the SIP to fund subs to cover teachers so that teachers may go to trainings and professional development.
 - b) We will save \$1,200.00 for the Gator Express on November 9th, 2019.
 - c) The SAC Committee was presented with two funding proposals.
 - d) Deputy Newman proposed that we use \$690.00 of the treasury balance to purchase 5 new radios so that more teachers have access to information in case of an emergency. Cell phone service is limited so radios are often times our only form of communication. The SAC Committee unanimously voted to use \$690.00 to purchase 5 new radios. The committee also suggested a dress down day to fund additional radios for safety purposes. Mr. Faust was going to check to see if that was possible.
 - e) Mrs. Odom proposed that the committee fund two tricycles and a trailer to be used as a book bike to visit low income kids. The students would be able to pick out a book. Total cost would be \$388.00 for two bikes and a trailer or \$236.99 for one bike and a trailer. The committee suggested advertising our

need on Facebook to see if we could receive any donations to fund this project. The Committee decided to advertise the project for two weeks on Facebook and we Tentatively approved to purchase one bike and one trailer if we did not receive a donation within two weeks time. The vote was unanimous.

Meeting was adjourned at 4:40 PM by Principal Adam Faust. The next general meeting will be on October 8, 2019, in Room 514 at 4:00 PM.
