**Call to Order:** Meeting called to order at 4:05 p.m. Attendees introduced themselves.

**Minutes:** Meeting minutes from February 2019 were reviewed and a motion to pass was made by Lorri Dior and seconded by Regina Davis.

Dr. Lord stated next meeting would be held after FSA scores are in. At that time we will discuss outcomes. Both FSA and I-Ready scores can be secured to advance students if FSA does not meet or exceed required score. Students and families are notified if the student has not met requirement or if at below grade level. Summer school is provided at Liberty and Osceola starting in June. Parents can access test scores on FOCUS and will be informed on how to locate that information. Mrs. Kingston, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade interventionist pulls students daily who do not receive ESE services to help get them to level.

Dr. Lord also reports she will once again be doing the principal's challenge with some extra marketing. Dr. Lord discussed the Parent Survey the district requires to be accessed thru FOCUS. Discussion on need for parent access to be better explained to parents, as many are unaware of FOCUS and what to find there. Reasoning behind FOCUS access to survey was so it would prevent "anyone" from accessing the survey, whereas it was originally posted to Facebook. FOCUS requires registration by parents, one account for all children.

**Old Business:**

- Reading support – with use of district funds, Looking at each students are of need. PLC's have helped. I-Ready is very specific and Mrs. Gabbard has been able to assist PLC by grade level, looking at Data. Both Reading and Math data gives teachers the needed information.
- FSA – 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade has completed writing and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade has completed Reading. 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will be taking I-Ready end of April. K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> do I-Ready in May. 5<sup>th</sup> grade with do Language Arts first week in May, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> will take Math second week in May and 5<sup>th</sup> will do Science. 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> have tested 100% of students at this time.



**New Business:**

- End of year – May is very busy. Many processes are being looked at. What is the school doing that is working and what is not working? The newsletter, helpful in getting the information out. Communication between teachers and parents, learning as you go, may need to be clearer. Challenor recommended a booklet to be issued or possibly a link on website that would be helpful in getting parents information on what things are going on at the school. Dr. Lord reported the newsletter should help with that, however appreciated the feedback. Challenor stated she felt knowing what is going on could be helpful in motivating students.

SAC will meet again in the summer, however we will wait until FSA scores come out to schedule.

Dr. Lord made a motion to adjourn meeting at 5:05 p.m. Regina Davis seconded the motion.
