Principal's Report

- 1) The treasury has a balance of \$3,521.32
- 2) We added a new Gator to the team! Congratulations Mrs. Borengasser on welcoming her new baby girl! We are working on adding a long-term sub as her replacement.
- 3) Safety Update: FSSP Florida Safe Schools Portal will be an information hub for the school threat assessment team.
- 4) 11/21/19 will be a jersey day to support teachers.
- 5) We are going to do a schoolwide recycling initiative. Recycling materials will be supplied to rooms and the cafeteria.
- 6) Gator Express- We will be bringing two busses; the Learning Alliance will not be bringing their bus.

New Business

- 1. A+ Recognition Funds: When we move the school grade up funding goes to the school. Faculty and staff voted on how to spend the funding. They voted on non-recurring faculty and staff bonuses. The bonuses will be shared evenly among all staff who worked at Glendale Elementary School last year. It will be prorated for part time staff members. The SAC Team voted on if they approve the disbursement of bonus funding.
 - The SAC voted unanimously to approve the school recognition funding.
- 2. Gator Express will leave this Saturday at 10:00 a.m. and return around 1:00 p.m. Mr. King could donate \$1,300 in gift cards from Publix & Wal-Mart in order to support members of the community with their holiday grocery bills.
