School Advisory Committee 2013-14

The SRMS School Advisory Committee (SAC) meeting took place on Monday, February 24, 2014 at 3:45 pm. In attendance were: Cindy Emerson – Asst. Principal; Meredith Tatro, and Juan Rojas - teachers; Carol Scaramuzzi, and Caroline Maschhoff, - parents.

The January minutes were approved.

School Improvement Plan: ESE Update – Goal #6: To work with students with disabilities to raise their AMO Reading Data to show at least 30% of students demonstrating proficiency. AMO Reading Data for Students with Disabilities 2013 Proficient = 28%, 2014 Target = 34%. A lot of learning gains are being made (especially compared to other schools in the district), but not meeting AMO. Progress tracking so far this year has been very positive.

Mrs. Tatro shared the SDIRC SAC handbook sections that were recommended to be discussed. One section discussed the importance of attendance at SAC meetings, and the other focused on only voting when there is Quorum (50% +1 members in attendance).

FCAT Writes+ is tomorrow, Feb. 25th for 8th Graders. 6th and 7th graders will be taking a practice FCAT Writes+ (as always) to prepare.

February 20th was SRMS' first "Night of Excellence" to reward students for attendance, athletics, and honor roll for both the first and second nine weeks. It was a wonderful night.
