The SRMS School Advisory Committee (SAC) meeting took place on Monday, March 31, 2014 at 3:45 pm. The February minutes were approved.

Possible School Grade Changes: Mr. Kramek shared an article from the Scripps Treasure Coast Newspaper titled “Changes to how schools graded could be coming”. A new test developed by the AIR (American Institutes for Research) will take the place of FCAT testing. It will be field tested in Utah. In the meantime, Reading and math are going through textbook adoptions right now to prepare for this new test.

Moonshot Moment Pledge: The community is being asked to sign the Moonshot Moment Pledge for improving literacy in our county. SAC attendees were given the pledge and asked to sign the form that will go to the School District office.

Audits: We have had two audits recently. The first was a Title 1 audit to determine the homeless rate of our students, and ensure that there is no discrimination towards these students and they are anonymous. The second audit was by the FDOE (Florida Department of Education) doing a bullying/harassment audit. SRMS passed both audits with flying colors.
