- Florida FCAT Writing scores are back;
  - Mean prompt score was 4.0; 5% scored 6; 97% scored 3 or better; 235 students scored 4 or better
- Mr. Racine , school purchased program for scoring writing prompts, "Write Score"
  - Allows teacher to see where students need improvement. This year; elaboration/details
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade orientation, 300 people came, tour school
  - Cowboy Camp will be August 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> 2011
  - There will be an A.M and P.M. sessions, 40 students per session
