- Data Review Power Point
 - Distance learning, I-Ready usage for TCE (now using a 50+min guideline during distant learning)

ELA Usage as of 1 week ago

• Top 5 in all ethnic groups (except Asian & Am. Indian...fewer students in this group)

Higher number of students effects the overall usage mins.

Teachers are maintaining communication to monitor I-Ready usage through emails and telephone calls.

District will be implementing more programs than I-Ready in the future to monitor benchmark scores

Main concern now is lessons passed and making sure communication is ongoing for those students struggling. Administration steps in when usage has dropped, and all communication efforts have been exhausted.

Diagnostic Status in I-Ready: Tabby Esposito

- Testing will begin Mon. May 11th Wed May 13th
- Students log into class link and click on ELA or Math and the assessment will automatically pull up
- All students must be supervised during the students time on the assessment. Parents cannot coach their child in anyway, but can give encouragement.
- The test is time consuming, so students should work for approx.. 30 mins., then take a break.
- Student must score a 70% or better. If not, the student may need to be retested.

These Diagnostic scores are not being used in the decision making for advancement for the next school year.

Any student being retained have already been notified and the proper steps have been taken.

Student Supply Pick-Up: Tabby Esposito

- The supply p/u dates and times have been posted on the school's web site as well as on the TCE Facebook page.
- The teachers and staff will be following CDC guidelines, with social distancing, wearing masks and washing hands often.
- There will be no physical contact with any students at any time.
- The student's belongings have been placed in a bag and will be placed in the trunk of the car or open window.
- No one will be allowed to exit their cars at any time!
- Parents with multiple students in different grades will need to communicate with the teachers to plan a pickup day that allow them to pick up all the children's belongings at the same time.
