# III Principal's Report:

Ms. Vernette spoke about our structured walk through that was conducted by the District on October 14, 2019. District saw most of instructional methods being implemented in the classroom setting. Areas to grow would be in adding more standard-based questions and higher order questions to instructional routines, and aligning center activities and lesson tasks to fully support the standard being taught.

Mrs. Racine spoke about the Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) survey results with the SAC members. (PFEP) is a document that allows Dodgertown Elementary School which is a Title I school the opportunity to communicate with families in multiple ways: for example: conferences, newsletters, phone calls, school marquee. PFEP also builds family involvement and capacity by having flexible meetings like parent nights, conferences, academic events, school-wide performances. PFEP also provides families with resources, Title I parent meetings, and other academic ways to access information to support students within the school. Mrs. Racine shared the results of the survey. Parents, community members, and faculty had opportunities to ask questions, make suggestions, and provide feedback regarding the Parent and Family Engagement Plan survey results. (PFEP). Mrs. Racine spoke about attendance data and showed a graph of school-wide attendance and then attendance broken down by grade levels. Mrs. Racine said that a committee of faculty and staff would help "buddy up" with students who are having attendance issues. Our goal for DTE is to increase attendance to 97% schoolwide by the end of the school year.

A motion to adjourn was made by Barbara Pearce and seconded by Laticia (Nikki) Boswell the meeting was adjourned at 8:40am
