Ms. Vernetta spoke about the Moonshot Academy partnering with The Learning Alliance we are starting on January 12-April 22, 2021 targeting students in Grade 1-3. The program will focus on literacy and phonics. Ms. Vernetta shared that our students will be having other extended day tutoring opportunities in math and in literacy as we focus on closing any achievement gaps and following our SIP plan. Ms. Vernetta shared updates on our STEAM lab grant. Ms. Laviska and other members of the STEAM lab committee are working hard to order supplies and materials to make DTE a well-known STEAM-lab, community partnership school that focuses on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics. Ms. Vernetta shared that students in K-5 completed the i-Ready diagnostic for the winter and that students make growth and gains in all grade levels. SAC did not have any funds requested to be used at this time.
