She shared images of students with I Ready books, which provide scaffolded skills in reading for grade 3, 4, & 5 graders in Tier 2 groups. She hopes that SAC can continue to fund this curriculum next year. She shared an image of Sonday card decks and described how they are filled with sight words, letter sounds, etc. She also showed teacher and student resources. Sonday is researched based and used throughout the country to intervene with struggling K, 1, & 2 students. She would like to perhaps ask SAC to purchase one more Sonday kit moving forward in the fall. In addition, she has reached out to the Learning Alliance to partner with them in the future.

**Principal's Report:** Natalie Ern reported that tomorrow is our 100<sup>th</sup> day celebration, and that we expect Dr. Moore will be here to witness some of our activities. We are in the process of conferences this week, and there is no school on Friday or Monday. We are preparing for the FSA. One of the dates already secured is April 7<sup>th</sup> for FSA ELA in third grade. We have a dress down day on 2/19. Finally, we have another round of Impact Reviews on 2/22 this month.
