Principals Update

- Dr. Robinson that we had our District Impact Review today where district and Oslo staff members walked through 21 classrooms to look for trends. Our impact review went good, but we noticed that we have to work on monitoring.
- The school has been approved to be repainted. The school will be light grey with light blue/royal blue trim to match our school colors.
- Tutoring is still available, and some teachers are beginning to offer on Monday.
- Water Bottles have continued to be a struggle through COVID Dr. Robinson mentioned that he is hoping to get approved to purchase reusable water bottles for students.
- On February 23 we will have our school wide stop and write to gather writing data for our students as we enter the FSA testing time to provide appropriate interventions.
- We received a grant through the state for an additional 44,000 that will be used for outreach, professional development, and interventions for students. We are planning to have Saturday bootcamps for our tested areas beginning in March/April to help prior to testing.

 - Last meeting Ms. Moore was approved \$1300 to purchase a 6th, 7th, and 8th grade Top Score Writing kit at 425.00 each. The official quote came back from the company for \$1372, so tonight we are asking SAC to approve another \$100 which would be a total of \$1400.00 to purchase Top Score Writing kits.
