**Approval of Minutes:** A motion was made by Curtis Carpenter to approve February's minutes and was seconded by Dawn Wagner. The minutes were unanimously approved.

**Budget:** Our district SAC balance is \$3,033.63, and we have \$11,338.57 in our Walter Johnson/ Curriculum support account. Our fundraising account has a \$4,500 balance.

**Use of SAC FUNDS- Math Parent Night:** Mrs. Thomas is requesting \$600.00 for a virtual math meeting to help families support their children at home. There will be two live sessions conducted by Sarah Schaefer with Think Math. One session will be for K-2<sup>nd</sup> grades from 5-6 and for 3<sup>rd</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> grades from 6-7 on zoom. It will also be recorded for later viewing. Kevin Oberlink made a motion to approve the funds and Laura Rodocaj seconded the motion. It was approved unanimously.

**MSA School of Distinction:** Janine Jones announced that we won a Magnet Schools of America award as a merit school of distinction based on diversity, data, lower quartile test scores, etc. They also looked at our math/ science focus and integration of the forementioned throughout our campus. Due to Covid, the announcement of winners was delayed. They are doing this virtually later this month. They have asked us to put together a small video with a few words of appreciation from school parents. Laura Rodocaj, Le Kooc, and Curtis Carpenter volunteered to send in a sentence that acknowledges this achievement by the end of the week.

**Principal's Report:** Tomorrow we have a group of people for Impact Walks coming in tomorrow to tour the school. There will be 13 principals, and a couple of state representatives, as well as others coming to look for evidence of strands that contribute to a "rope of literacy". FSA is coming up the first week of April, after Spring Break. The Ribbon Cutting Ceremony has been moved to next year.
