- ❖ Approval of April 16, 2019 Minutes. Jackie Ogilvie motioned to approve, Marie Taglione seconded. All in favor, none opposed.

- ❖ **Funding Requests**-2019-2020 Starting balance: **\$10,692.00**
 1. **SWAG**-Patty Giordano requested \$250.00 for SWAG events for September thru November. Marie Taglione motioned to approve and Meredith Tatro seconded it. All in Favor, none opposed.
 2. **After School Buses**-Mr. Racine requested \$2,000 to pay for two busses for SRMS after school program starting September 12th Cynthia Lowe motioned to approve, Kenneth Brown seconded it. All in Favor, None Opposed.
 3. **Cafeteria Monitors/School Safety**- Mr. Racine requested \$2,275.00 to pay for 6 Café monitors (2 each lunch daily) and \$750.00 for after school detention monitor on Thursdays (total of \$3,025.00). Briceli Gamez motioned to approve, Jackie Ogilvie seconded it. All in Favor, None opposed.
 4. **Family Newsletter** (Mrs. Berchtold Emerging Leaders Class)-\$2,000 was requested however, Mrs. Tatro brought up discussion committee had last year about defraying cost by asking local companies to advertise for a fee. Possibly have students from class write letters requesting advertising. Another suggestion in lieu of copies newsletter link on Focus. After much discussion the proposal of giving half of the funds now (\$1,000) and Fundraise for cost of 2nd semester. Jackie Ogilvie motioned to approve, Briceli Gamez seconded it. All in favor, None opposed.

5. **FCCSS Continuing Education**-Anne Powell requested \$350.00 for 2 social studies teachers to attend workshops. Request includes workshop fee and lodging, teacher(s) will handle other expenses incurred. Kenneth Brown motioned to approve, Cynthia Lowe second. All in favor, none opposed.
