4. How does a homeschool student qualify to participate?

a. Homeschool students who complete a project and submit the paperwork on time can participate in Indian River Regional Science and Engineering Fair (IRRSEF)

5. Does a homeschool student have to participate in a local school fair?

a. No. The homeschool community MAY host a fair, however ALL homeschool students who have approved paperwork and a complete project can participate in IRRSEF.

6. When must science projects need to be completed by?

a. Projects must be completed by December 15th, as well as paperwork for the project.

7. What is the deadline to turn in paperwork?

- a. Pre-approval deadline is October 22, 2021. (For special projects such as human studies, species collection, etc.)
- b. Final paperwork deadline is December 15, 2021
