- Meeting began at 4:03 pm
- Mrs. Jobe gave a treasurer's report. SAC has a balance of \$3,434.64.
- Ms. Halleran and Mrs. Jobe made a motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting that was held in May.
- Mr. Keen reviewed The Family Engagement plan that is currently in place at PIE. A few of the ways parents want to be communicated with and kept aware of important events include:

  - Social media: Facebook and Twitter

Mr. Keen also shared that the Parent Compact will be signed with parents on conference night.

- Ms. Bagley presented the SIP: There are 366 students overall.

• Goal 1- Academics: Using ELA and math data to drive instruction that is aligned to Florida ELA Best standards and Florida Math standards.

## Action Plan:

- 1. Weekly team collaborative planning with instructional coaches, with a focus on differentiation.
- 2. Monthly data chats
- 3. Professional Development including a schoolwide book study using the book "Advancing Formative Assessment in Every Classroom".
- Goal 2- Theme: Focus will be cross-curricular STEAM education

Action Plan- weekly collaborative meetings to with coaches or administration to ensure that teachers are implementing Discovery Ed. with fidelity. We will also continue professional development with the curriculum.

• Goal 3- Culture: focus on cultural responsiveness and restorative practices.

## Action Plan:

- 1. Implementation of Sanford-Harmony social emotional learning program, which most of our teachers are familiar with.
- 2. School-wide PBIS: monthly meetings held to discuss data, positive rewards, and interventions that may be needed. This program is supported by the entire school.
- Ms. Bagley also presented FSA data for the 20-21 school year and compared it to the 18-19 school year:
