K-5 Iready Testing Window

November 29th - December 17th - Winter Diagnostic window. A schedule will be shared. Remind students, by having class and/or data chats about their required time needed on Iready Reading & Math each week. District sets the weekly goal as 45 minutes for each subject with students passing their lessons. If students reach this goal each week they will progress through the program, their individualized learning path, and the result is better diagnostic scores and reaching their expected growth. If this information is shared with students, they will then know the reason for this work.

How many times as a student do you remember asking yourself, "Why am I needing to do this assignment, or why am I learning this?" Once you knew the work seemed easier. If students are absent and they have access to a computer, suggest to the parent that if the student feels up to it, work on their iready lessons.
