

# Glendale Elementary - School Advisory Committee

## Meeting Minutes

November 8, 2021

### Call To Order

The regular meeting of the Glendale Elementary - School Advisory Committee was called to order at 6:06 PM on 11-08-2021 in room 514 by SAC Chairman Patty Poysell.

### Present

### Approval of Minutes

Molly noted that the name Allison Parker is incorrect and should be changed to Ashley Allison. Minutes were approved with a motion by Nadine Chauvet and seconded by Molly McCloskey.

### Old Business

- a) SAC funds – current balance \$6500.
- b) Gator Express: the purpose is to distribute books to our students. In the past, the school schedules a bus from the district for the distribution. Kona Ice has followed the school bus around the neighborhood in past years and SAC pays for the smallest cup. Patty asked the committee members if they believe that Gator Express can be organized before Christmas break. Nadine said she will check with Kona to see if they are available. Patty Poysell will look at where the books left over from the last Express were stored. Looking at the calendar possible dates could be December the 11<sup>th</sup>, December 4<sup>th</sup>, or waiting until after Christmas.

### New Business

- a) **Food Drive:** According to Sally a family reached out that they would like to donate 10 turkey's and trimmings. Ken said that Mrs. Ferguson's would also like to donate 30 turkey's and baskets of other food items. Ken said that Mrs. Ferguson's is expecting a phone call this evening and Nadine will make that call. It was asked if PTA is still donating the \$500 for the turkeys. It was decided that we will find out first what Mrs. Ferguson's donation will include. The students who are homeless pose a new problem because they may not have a way to cook the food. It was suggested that maybe the PTA could donate gift cards for restaurants.
- b) **Title 1 Family Engagement Survey:** Ken Brown reviewed the survey results and every participate received a copy of the results to review. Because of the green status of our school parent lunches are beginning again, Glendale University has begun, and Art Club have all begun or will begin soon. Fourth and third grade will be going on field trips again this year. Ken can print out the survey and its results or email the results to anyone who desires a copy.
- c) **Driveline:** Ken discussed the success of the Driveline and the average time is 30 minutes from start to finish.
- d) **New Radio:** Ken and Cassie are proposing that SAC purchase 10 radios for the teachers and ESE teachers for the cost of \$1824.50. Ken discussed the safety concerns with the lack of working radios for all teachers and ESE specialist. Because there are not enough voting members in attendance, we did not have a quorum, therefore; the on the purchase will be delayed until the next meeting on December 13<sup>th</sup>.

- e) **Honor Roll/Student of the Month:** Molly M. asked about students being recognized for their achievements. At this time the COVID restrictions are not allowing the past recognition in front of families, however, administration has visited different classrooms to honor those students at the request of the teachers.
