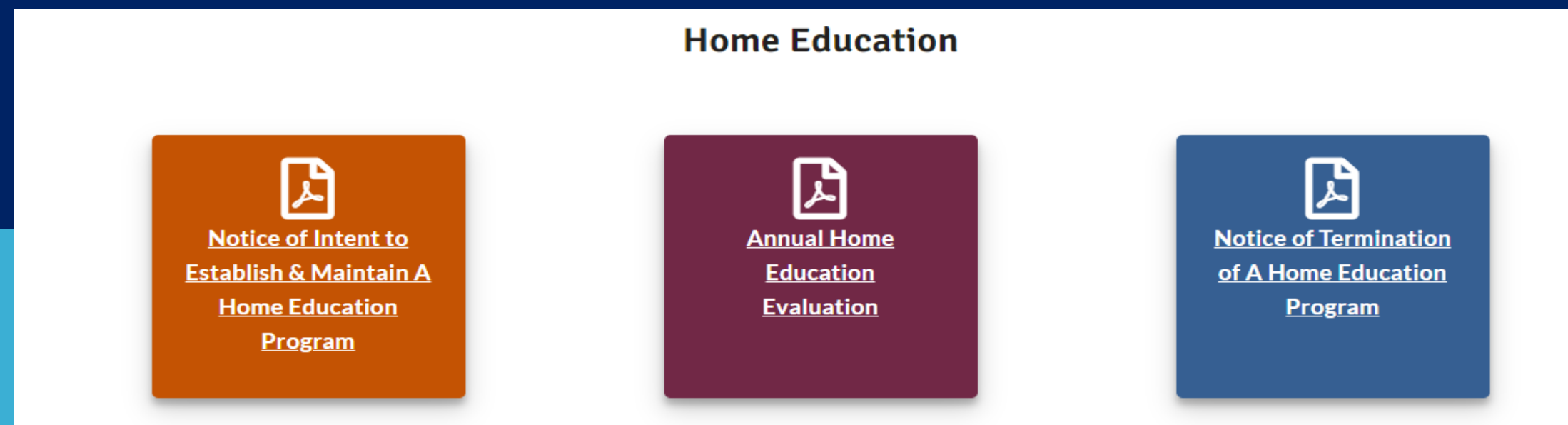

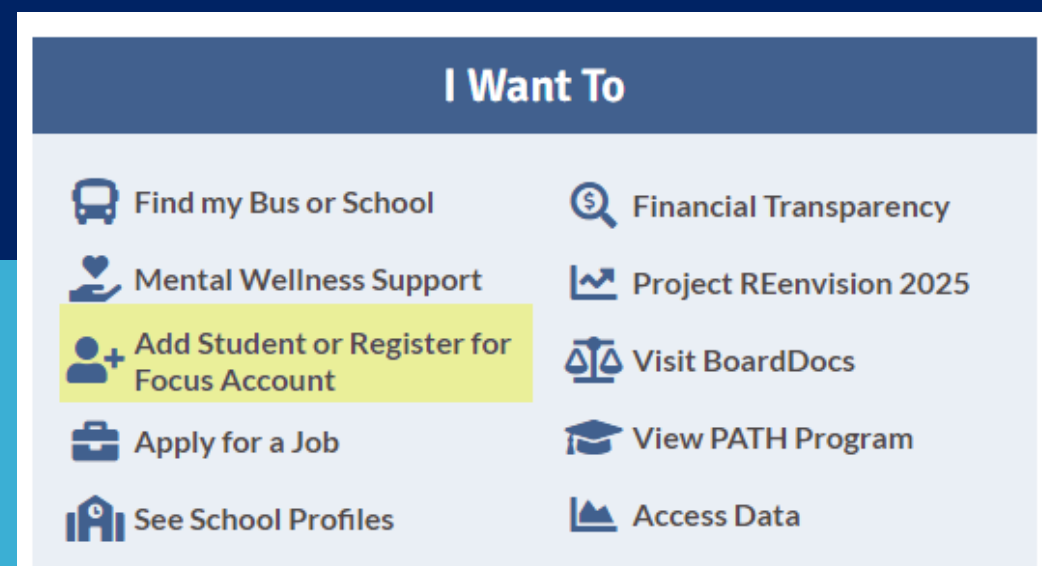

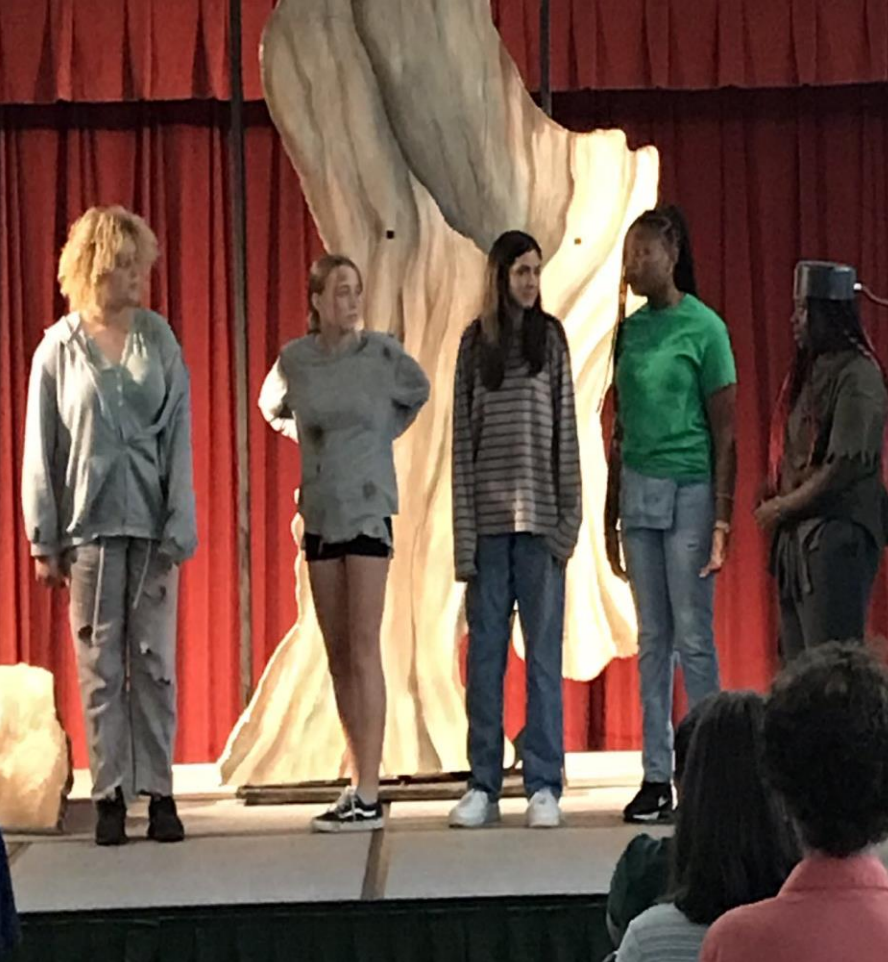

The Dual Enrollment Program



The Dual Enrollment is program where students achieve high school and college credits at the same time. Dual enrollment is Florida's largest college "scholarship" program. More than 70,000 students participate in Florida's DE program. 93% of DE students enroll in college soon after high school graduation. 64% of DE students complete a postsecondary credential. Tuition fees and textbook costs are **FREE** to dual enrolled students who attend an eligible home school.

Dual Enrollment Eligibility & Credit



Eligible Dual Enrollment students must have a minimum of a 3.0 (UW) GPA for college credit courses or a minimum of 2.0 (UW) GPA for Career Training courses. They must also achieve a minimum score on the PERT, ACT or SAT.

Students must have a written approval from a Parent / Guardian. Dual Enrollment courses are weighted the same in high school as Honors, A.P., I.B. and A.I.C.E. classes.

Dual Enrollment credit is college credit and is permanent on college transcripts. Course retakes are at the student's expense.

Home Education Textbooks

- Home education students registering for Dual Enrollment at IRSC must provide proof of enrollment in a home education program pursuant to Florida Statutes 232.02(4) and an articulation agreement must be signed by the parent and the student. Students may receive textbooks upon the completion of the registration process, by providing a copy of the student's id and class schedule at the IRSC bookstore. All textbooks must be returned at the end of each semester.

1. Apply to IRSC at www.irsc.edu
2. Take the P.E.R.T., or submit official college placement scores (ACT® or SAT®) that are no more than two years old.
3. Complete and submit the Dual Enrollment Program Agreement (Form 508) and the Dual Enrollment Registration (Form 68)
4. Sign and submit the Dual Enrollment Articulation agreement with proof of enrollment in a Home Education Program.
5. Complete the Dual Enrollment Online Orientation
6. Enroll in college courses (SLS1101 must be the first course for New students)

DUAL ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

Indian River State College

And

The Home School

Whereas Section (a) 1007.271 (2), Florida Statutes, requires state colleges and Home Schools to develop comprehensive Dual Enrollment articulation agreements, Indian River State College (IRSC), and The Home School have made the following determinations:

- A) Terms of this Agreement shall commence August 1, 2020, or on the last date approved by either party, whichever is later, and end upon the student's high school graduation date specified in their academic record, unless terminated as hereinafter provided.
- B) Annual Articulation meetings shall take place between Home School, Parent/Guardian and IRSC to review this agreement to assure all parties that it continues to serve their mutual interests and provide student opportunities. Proof of enrollment in a Home School Program from the student's local school district must be on file at IRSC to participate in Dual Enrollment.
- C) Either party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement by delivery of a written notice to the other party not less than sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of said termination.
- D) The parties to this Agreement recognize that as provided under Section (a) 1007.271 (2), F.S., and SBE Rule 6A-14.064, accelerated mechanisms such as Dual Enrollment/Early College and advanced (college-level) instructional programs for qualified students from the Home Schools enhance learning opportunities and are required to be made available for those students.
- E) The parties will adopt an Agreement as provided in Section 1007.271 (2), F.S., and SBE Rule 6A-14.064, including:
 1. College Credit Dual Enrollment
 2. Vocational Credit Dual Enrollment
- F) All dual enrollment students must complete IRSC's Dual Enrollment Online New Student Orientation, Dual Enrollment New Student Orientation is required for all new IRSC students and includes information on college policies, procedures, resources, expectations, and other essential items that help support student success. Students who do not complete DE NSO will be unable to register for their dual enrollment classes until this requirement has been met.
- G) In the unlikely event of any local natural disaster or pandemic, which may disrupt program services and/or access to these services, the Post-secondary institution may make modifications to this agreement as supported by the Florida Statutes, 1007.271 and communicated to the Home School within 30 days of the change.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I Definition of Escating Agreement: All existing dual enrollment agreements between IRSC, and the Home School are hereby modified to conform to the terms of this agreement and the appendices of this document.

Treasure Coast Technical College Dual Enrollment

Homeschool students must:

- Meet the following requirements: Must present qualifying scores on a CPT-Accuplacer, SAT, ACT or PERT test.
- Submit the following paperwork: Submit the Career Dual Enrollment application and Dual Enrollment Articulation Agreement signed by both the student and Parent/Guardian.
